A comprehensive guide to the present-day matters which gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender people are concerned with. One goal of this class is to expand the thinking of the individuals who belong to these groups as well as the thinking of their family, friends and any persons in their lives.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course represents an overview of issues affecting lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people, including politics, religious concerns, and especially education at all levels, from elementary school through college. Students of all sexual orientations and gender identities are welcome. Disclosing one's identity is not required.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Demonstrate an ability to participate in difficult discussions
- Understand the difference among lesbians, gay men, bisexual people, and transgender people
- Increase awareness of the issues affecting the LGBT communities
- Understand the broad spectrum of oppression
- Increase skills to serve as advocates and allies for people different from yourself
